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
## Report of Antiragging Awareness Programme

An 'Anti-Ragging Awareness Programme' was conducted in the institution on 13-09-2022 for the students. The programme was organized by the Antiragging cell in association with IQAC. Mr. V. Kuttappan, retired special SP was the resource person. The Programme was started at 02.30 p.m. in seminar hall with the welcome address by the antiragging cell convenor Dr. Baiju P. Jose. Principal Assoc. Professor Mini Mathew gave the presidential address.

The resource person Mr. V. Kuttappan started his speech with an explanation to ragging. He informed the gathering about the consequences of ragging. He said that even the honorable supreme court in its order has banned ragging in any form in institutions and many educational authorities like UGC, AICTE and the Governments have issued stern warning against ragging and proposed ways and means to curb the menace of ragging. He added that some laws also provide for disqualification or expulsion of student from the educational institution on conviction on the charge of ragging.
