Date: 13/03/23



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




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Report of the National Webinar on Enhance Your Creativity through Creative Writing Courses conducted on 23 March 2023


The webinar on "Solar Terrestrial Physics and Space Weather" was held on October 12, 2022, in conjunction with World Space Week. The session aimed to enhance understanding of the interactions between solar activities and their effects on Earth's atmosphere and space weather. The webinar witnessed active participation from students and faculty members, highlighting the growing interest in space science and its implications for our planet. The
