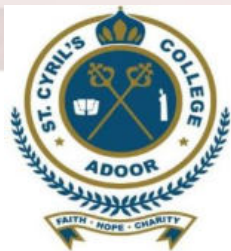

Analysis of Student feedback on teachers

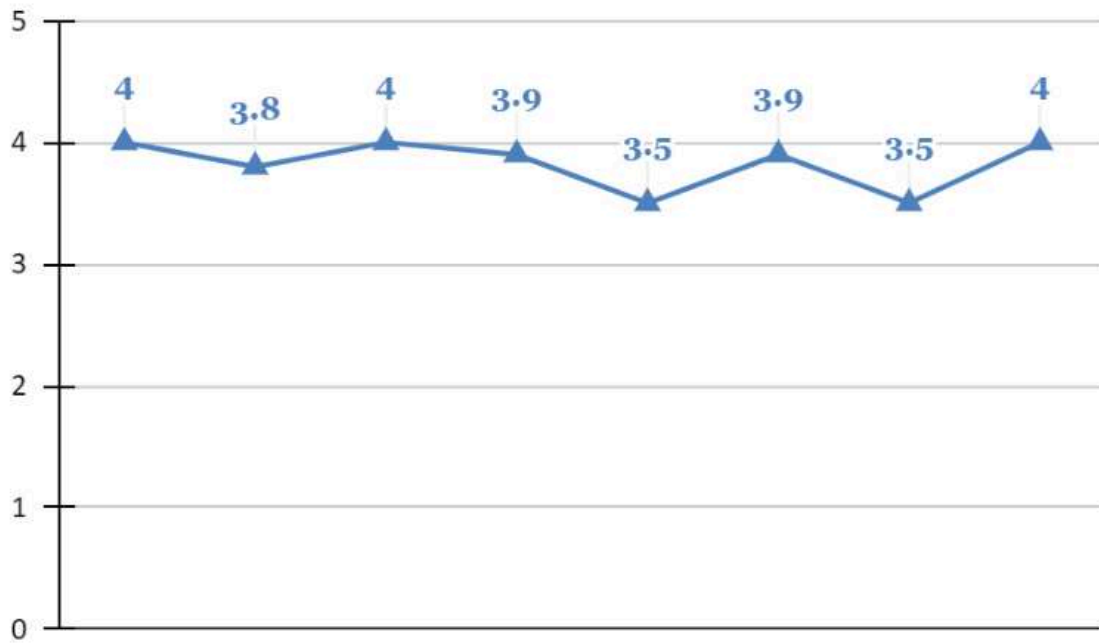
The students have evaluated their teacher's skills by giving ratings on the following eight parameters.

1	Knowledge base of the teacher(as perceived by you)
2	Communication Skills(In terms of articulation and comprehensibility)
3	Sincerity/Commitment of the teacher
4	Ability to integrate course material with environment/ other issues to provide a broader perspective
5	Ability to integrate content with other course
6	Accessibility of the teacher in and out of the class (includes availability of the teacher to motivate further study and discussion outside the class
7	Ability to design quizzes /tests/ assignments/examinations and projects to evaluate students understanding of the course
8	Interest generated by the teacher

The maximum point that can be given for a single parameter is four while the minimum point is one' A detailed diagrammatic representation of the-points secured by the departments is shown below' The x-axis shows the above listed parameters represented by their corresponding serial number while the Y-axis indicates the rating obtained.

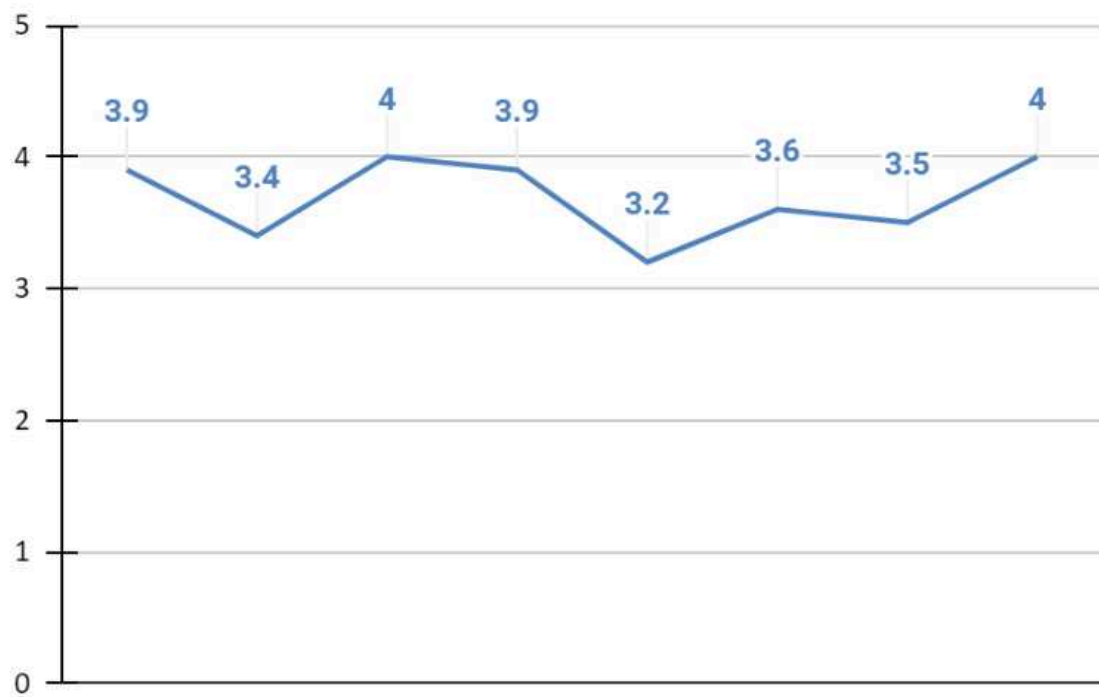

Average ratings Departmental Comparison



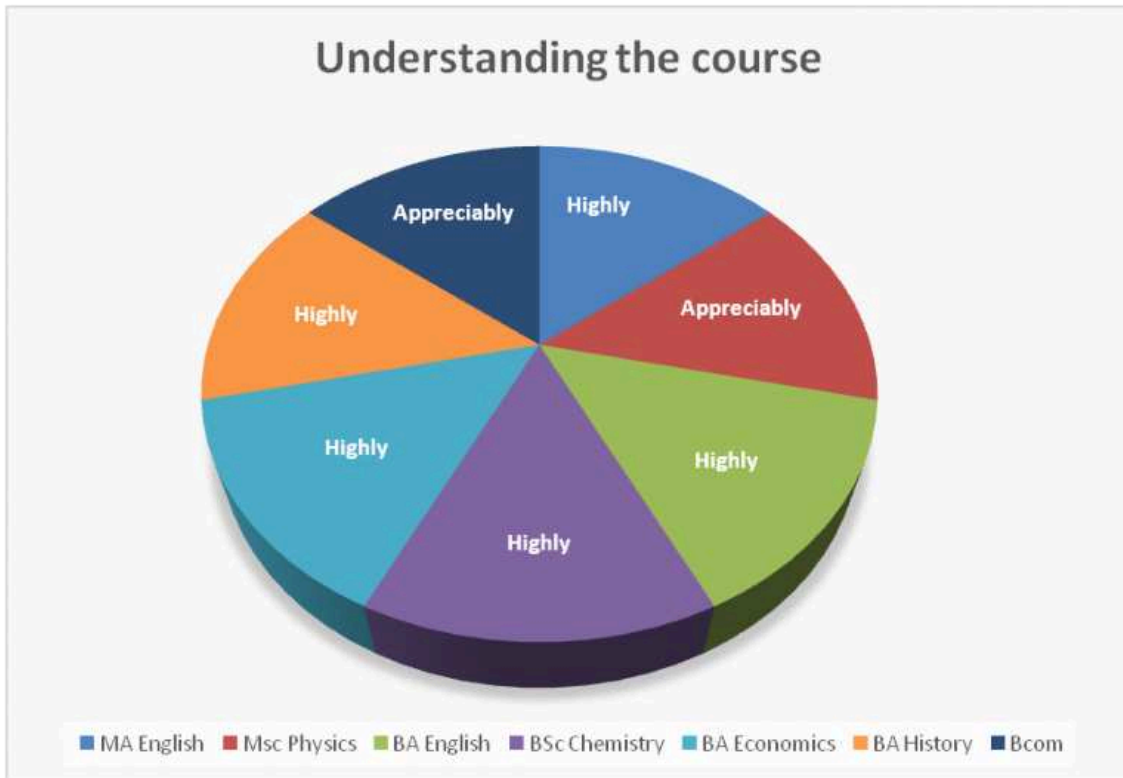
Feedback on curriculum

The expectations of students on curriculum were analysed by the collection of feedback. The students can evaluate the curriculum on a five point scale where the student can mark eight parameters as highly, very Appreciably, Moderately, poorly and not at all. The parameters like understanding the course, early discovery of difficulties, interaction with the teacher, regular work and continuous self-assessment of the course are analysed and evaluated by the students. The students are not forced to write their names on the feedback form but for the purpose of proper evaluation they have to indicate their subjects. They can also add further suggestions in the bottom of the feedback form. The feedback is analysed department-wise to get a clear understanding of the course material. The following is an analysis of the consolidated data obtained from students of various departments:

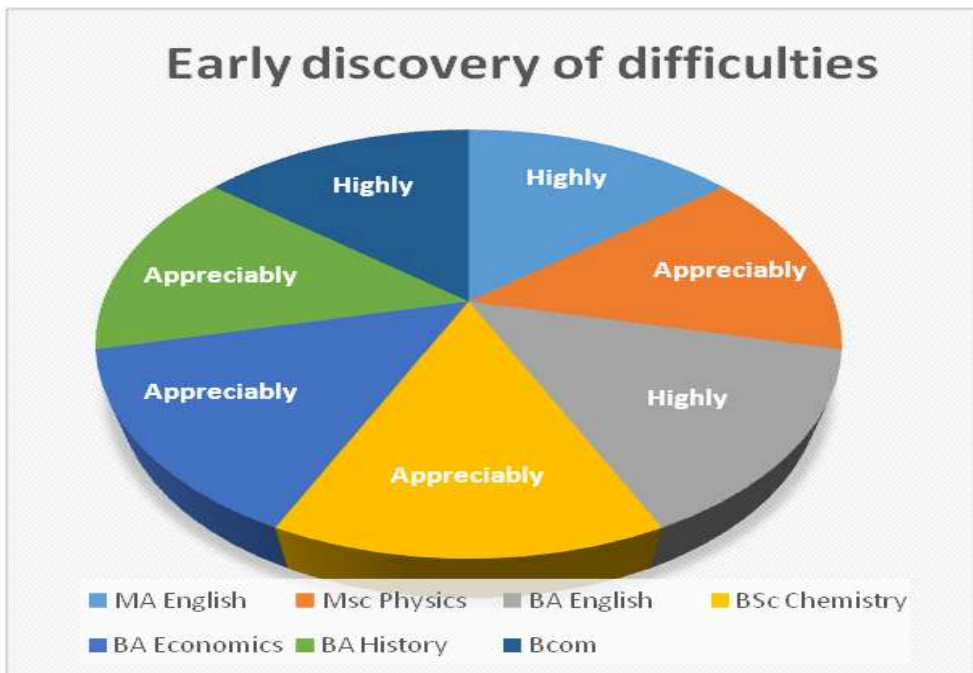

Feedback for the Institution collected from Parents

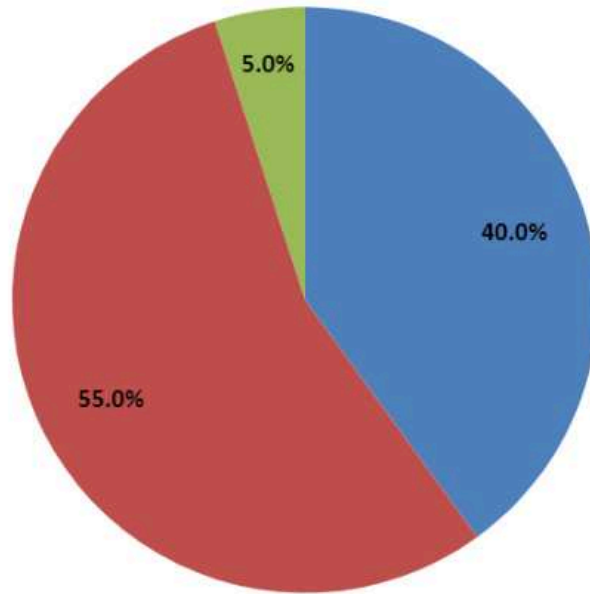

Contributions of college



Parents show considerable involvement in their children's academic lives, and they play an active role in providing thoughtful and constructive feedback on the curriculum that students follow. The institution values this input and gathers feedback from parents during both the annual PTA meetings and department-specific PTA meetings. Feedback forms are provided in Malayalam to ensure that parents can easily convey their thoughts and concerns. These forms are designed to effectively evaluate key aspects of the educational experience, including syllabus implementation, library access, and the availability of other infrastructure on campus.

The feedback is collected through a detailed questionnaire consisting of fourteen questions, covering a wide range of topics. Additionally, there is a section for parents to share their advice and express their personal views about the college. This feedback has revealed that the majority of parents are satisfied with the quality of teaching, the contributions made by the college, the efficiency of the college office, and the overall discipline maintained on campus.

However, a few areas for improvement were noted. Some parents expressed concerns about the hygiene and quality of the canteen facilities, as well as the lack of certain basic amenities needed to enhance students' comfort. These concerns were promptly brought to the attention of the college development council, which took immediate action to address them.

Action taken report

- The concerns regarding canteen facilities and basic amenities were promptly reported to the College Development Council.
- The Council initiated immediate discussions to address the hygiene standards and quality of the canteen.
- Plans for upgrading facilities and enhancing amenities for students are currently being formulated.
- The college maintains open lines of communication with parents to ensure their feedback is valued.
- Ongoing assessments will be conducted to monitor improvements and further address any emerging issues.
